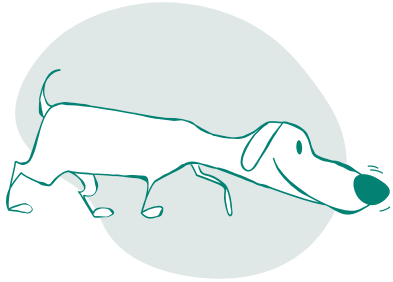


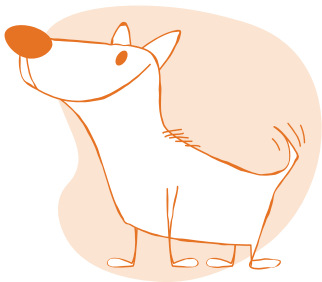
DOG PERSONALITIES

I THINK MY DOG IS MOST LIKE...



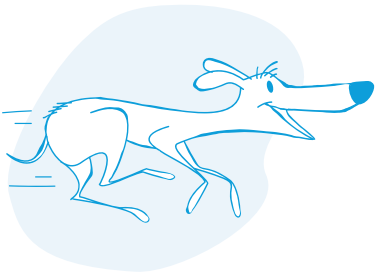
The Explorer

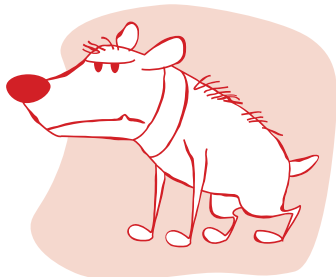
The Athlete
